- Classes in blue, without a strike through them will be offered at this year's event. Classes with a strike through them will **not** be offered.
- Each participant will be limited on the number of animals/classes they are able to exhibit within each department. Participants can show in multiple departments however they are limited on the amount of animals and/or classes they can show in each department as follows:
 - O Beef 1 market animal and 1 breeding animal per participant
 - Dairy 2 breeding animals per participant
 - Dairy Goat 2 breeding animals per participant
 - Meat Goat 1 market animal and 1 breeding animal per participant
 - Alpaca/Llama 1 animal per participant
 - Horse 2 animals per participant and can only show in 2 divisions per participant (total of 4 classes)
 - Sheep 1 market animal and 1 breeding animal per participant
 - Swine 1 market animal per participant
 - Poultry Each participant can sign up for 2 classes per specie (chickens, turkeys, ducks, and geese). Only 1 class per specie can be market.
 - Rabbits no live show see rabbit section for more details
- For species offering both market/breeding and showmanship class types, these classes will be judged simultaneously when feasible. For example, as a participant's market lamb is being judged by one judge, a second judge will also be evaluating the individual's showmanship skills. There will be identifiers for the judge to know the age group of that individual to ensure age is accounted for.
