

### The Ranch Event Complex - Modified Poultry Show - 2023 Larimer County Fair

The following information is shared as of May 8, 2023 and is contingent on changes.

We will continue to monitor and follow recommendations from the Check-in date, Tuesday, July 11<sup>th,</sup> through the designated check-out date for the show.

Entry into Fair Entry is due by 6/26/23.

**Market Birds will be shown** on Wednesday, July 12<sup>th,</sup> at the Thomas McKee 4-H Youth and Community Building Exhibition Hall – 5360 Arena Circle, Loveland, CO.

#### **Show Structure**

- 1. Terminal Show for Market Chickens, Turkeys, Geese, and Ducks.
- 2. Limit two entries per species per exhibitor.
- 3. Facility areas are restricted to exhibitors, judges, and four superintendents.
  - a. One parent may accompany the youth to put the birds in the cage.
- 4. The CSU Poultry team will be on-site to examine birds.
- 5. Exhibitors must have owned the birds for at least 30 days before the check-in date.
- 6. Exhibitors must have had the birds at the exhibitor's home consecutively during the period referenced in Provision 5.
- 7. Birds will be processed after the show, and exhibitors can pick up their birds and sell them to the buyback buyer.
- 8. Pictures of exhibitors with their market birds will be displayed during the Fair.
- 9. The Junior Livestock Sale Committee will include poultry (via pictures) in the auction.
- 10. Exhibitors will observe their birds daily for signs of influenza-like illness and must immediately report any influenza-like illness to the Fair Competitions Coordinator.

Based on the original show dates, we acknowledge that birds may not have achieved their desired weight based on original show dates.

#### **Biosecurity**

The McKee Exhibit Hall is inaccessible to other areas in the building, with the exception restrooms of restrooms.

- 1. There will be one entrance/exit into the facility.
- 2. Foot baths with a brush to remove organic material will be provided and must be used each time entering/exiting the Exhibit Hall. Tylosin spray, etc., will be used.
- 3. Gowns and latex gloves will be provided to cover personal clothing and hands and must be worn by every person in the facility.
- 4. Exhibitors are permitted to handle their animals only.
- 5. Outside personal items must be minimized.
  - a. Pockets must be emptied before entering the Exhibit Hall.
    - 6. The exhibitor must bring poultry food in labeled individual zip-lock bags.
    - 7. Items that enter the Exhibit will be destroyed at the show's end; remaining food, water dishes, etc.

- 8. Equipment sharing is prohibited; shavings, waterers, feeders, brooms, shovels & wheelbarrows are provided this is not an exclusive list.
- 9. The facility will be thoroughly disinfected after the birds leave and before other events.
- 10. Limit the time birds are congregated and co-mingled at an exhibition. Different species (chickens, turkeys, ducks, geese) should be separated in the exhibition.
- 11. Minimize interaction between birds from separate flocks.
- 12. Exhibitors must avoid personal contact with wildlife, especially wild birds and waterfowl prior to the show.
- 13. Exhibitors must keep their tools and equipment clean and clean cages and food and water containers daily.
- 14. Every person in the facility must wash their hands with soap and water often and clean footwear before and after entering the Exhibit Hall.
- 15. Under no circumstances may non-animal related activities, such as eating food, occur within the facility.

If a bird exhibits signs of sickness, it will be quarantined from the other birds, and the incidence will be reported.
