INFORMATION FOR BUYERS

Animals entered in this sale have been fed and raised by 4-H members. These young people have attended a Quality Assurance Program (MQA) and have verified that their animals are drug-free. Any monetary funds they receive above their expenses can be used at their discretion. They may choose to finance future 4-H projects, use for future education or to finance other worthwhile projects.

TERMS OF THE SALE

All purchased animals **MUST** be paid for at the conclusion of the sale. If this is not possible, contact a member of the Jr Livestock Sale Committee to make other arrangements. All accounts need to be settled as soon as possible in order to make payment to the 4-H youth. Acceptable payment methods are Cash, Check, or Credit Card (Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express). Checks should be made payable to the “Larimer County Junior Livestock Sale Committee” (LCJLSC). If mailed, the address is 5280 Arena Circle Suite 100, Loveland, Co 80538.

There will be a 2.7% processing fee for all credit card transactions.

This is a “**TERMINAL SALE.**” All animals are sold for consumption and will be controlled, handled, transported, and turned over to the meat processing agent by the Junior Livestock Sale Committee. Under **NO** circumstances will any animal(s) be allowed to leave the Fairgrounds under control or the possession of the buyer.

BUYER OPTIONS

OPTION A:

Buy Back: The buyer bids on an animal and upon the successful bid, the buyer pays the difference between the bid price and the established price listed in the program. The animal is then sold to a packer for the market price.

For Example: Bid is \$750 for a 130 lb. Lamb

Bid = \$750

Buy-Back (Market Price) = \$150

Buyer Pays = \$600 (Bid Price- Buy Back Price)

Food Bank Donation: As part of the buy-back option, a buyer can choose to donate the meat to the food bank. If the buyer chooses this option, the processor selected MUST be Colorado Custom Meats ONLY. This enables the Sale Committee to streamline and ensure all meat intended for the food bank, gets there. In this case, the Larimer County Food Bank will pay the processing fee.

OPTION B:

Animals may be purchased for the buyer's own personal consumption. Consider using it for employee incentives, a fund-raising activity, a picnic, or club barbecue. A list of local processors is listed in the program. Delivery to the processor will be arranged by the Livestock Sale Committee. Because of the USDA meat inspection restrictions and transportation expenses, all custom slaughter animals will be delivered to their designated destinations as indicated on the sale bill.

Additional Donations or Add-Ons are an easy and great way to increase the total sale price for a youth member and are really appreciated. The add-on amount gets directly credited to the total sale amount for the youth member you choose, and no bidding is necessary to participate. Additional contributions can also be made to a particular species or the overall Livestock Sale. In the essence of time the Livestock Sale Committee encourages that Add-Ons are made prior to or during the sale at the designated location (form attached) in the auction area. Add-ons cannot be accepted after 14 calendar days following the sale.

THE ONLY YOUTH MEMBERS ELIGIBLE FOR ADD ONS ARE THOSE THAT QUALIFY FOR THE SALE.

BUYER'S SIGNATURE

Buyers are asked to sign the purchase agreement that will be distributed immediately following the purchase. Please indicate if the animal is for "resale/buy-back", "Foodbank" or "custom processing". As indicated, processing arrangements should be made PRIOR to leaving the sale on custom slaughtered animals. Make sure you list the site where you wish your custom slaughter animal to be processed on the purchase agreement and complete the cutting instructions.

This is Julia's last livestock sale. She graduated from Rocky Mountain High School and is planning to attend the University of Northern Colorado to study psychology and art.



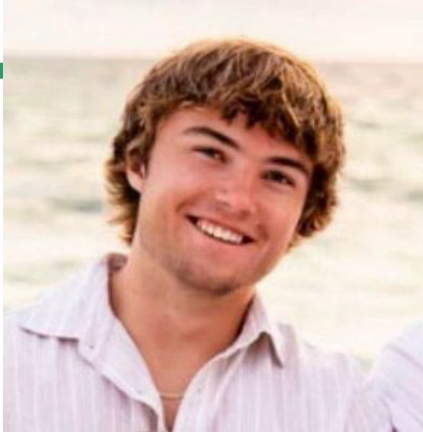
