4HOnline Registration Required by TUESDAY APRIL 23, 2024

LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED UNTIL TUESDAY APRIL 30 WITH \$25 LATE FEE (Entries received after April 30 will be able to ride exhibition only, no placings or prizes) Show is open for any youth enrolled in the 4-H Horse project in Colorado.

- Register for show via 4HOnline
- Payment is due the day of the show. Payment may be made by cash or check. Checks should be made out to Pueblo County 4-H Horse Council.
- Office charge: \$10 per exhibitor
- Entry fee: \$5 per class, maximum of \$45 per day
- Stock Charges: \$10 for Goat Tying, \$5 for Breakaway Roping, \$5 for Steer Daubing, \$25 for Level 2 and Level 3/4 Ranch Horse Division.
- Stalls available, **\$10 per stall per night**. Register for stalls in 4HOnline. Stalls MUST be cleaned prior to leaving show.
- Shaving and hay available for purchase at show or you can bring your own.
- Camping/RV spots available, \$45 per night

GENERAL PUEBLO COUNTY HORSE SHOW RULES:

- WRITTEN TEST FOR 4-H EXHIBITORS- Will be administered 1 hour prior to show start each day. All exhibitors must take test for each of their division.
- **Parents/Guardians/Adults** for the safety for all 4-H members, <u>a designated adult person must be present during</u> any County Fair Horse Event to be responsible for participants and their animals in case of emergency.
- Horse show office will open one hour prior to show time each day.
- NO YOUTH UNDER 8 CAN BE ON HORSEBACK.
- No refunds will be made unless the health of the horse or the health of the rider are an issue.
- Exhibitors are only allowed to show horses they have registered in 4HOnline.
- Please review your entries with your parents and/or club leader to make sure you are entering the correct classes for your age and riding level.
- 4-H Exhibitors must compete in a showmanship class to compete in any other classes.
- 4-H age groups (age 12/31/23): Senior 14-18 years old, Junior 8-13 years old.
- Breaks for tack changes, warm up and lunch will be taken where appropriate and will be announced. Please notify the gate person of any scheduling conflicts and show management will do their best to accommodate.
- <u>Protective Headgear Policy:</u> A certified equestrian helmet with SAFETY HARNESS SECURELY FASTENED IS REQUIRED in Over the fence classes and Gymkhana event (i.e., timed events not involving livestock). Including all activities associated with these events, such as practice sessions and warm-up. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian of the 4-H member to to see that the headgear worn complies with standards and is in good condition. It is encouraged to use a ASTM certified/SEI approved safety helmet in all events. <u>All mounted riders on the grounds</u> must wear a safety helmet and must be fastened regardless of whether you are entered in gymkhana classes or English Over Fence Classes. Non-compliance with these rules could result in disqualification from classes
- It is the expectation of the Superintendent and CSU Extension management that ALL horses and riders, regardless of age or level will maintain control at all times. Any special accommodations necessary for the safety of the 4-H member should be brought to the Superintendent's attention before classes begin if possible.
- Show will be run in in accordance with the current 2024 Colorado State 4-H Horse Show Rulebook & 2024 Pueblo County Fair Book rules. (See Pueblo County specific rules below.)

GYMKHANA DIVISION

- **PER COLORADO STATE 4-H RULES**: All riders must wear ASTM Certified/SEI Approved Safety Helmets during all Gymkhana events and warmup.
- Beginner 4-H riders are allowed to enter Beginner WALK/TROT All Age Gymkhana events but are only allowed to ride at <u>Walk or Trot</u>. Loping during event will constitute a disqualification in that Gymkhana event.
- Parent's discretion is advised when allowing youth to participate in gymkhana events.
- All mounted riders during Gymkhana Events must wear a safety helmet and it must be fastened regardless of whether you are entered in gymkhana classes or not.

WESTERN DIVISION

- It will be optional for Beginner Western riders to use either one or two hands on the reins in all walk/trot classes. Legal tack for this division should be used -- refer to Colorado 4-H Horse Show Rulebook updated 2024.
- BEGINNER TRAIL RIDERS CHOOSE ONLY THREE OBSTACLES (BEGINNERS DOING MORE THAN 3 OBSTACLES WILL CONSTITUTE OFF PATTERN AND A SCORE OF ZERO)

FOAL/GREEN HORSE DIVISION

- Exhibitors must have attained a Level 2 or above status to show a Foal or Green Horse.
- Green Horse classes are to help youth starting to train a new horse and give them valuable arena experience. NO
 POINTS WILL BE AWARDED FOR THESE CLASSES. The horse may only be shown in Green Horse classes
 for one year. A green horse may not return to 4-H Green Horse classes once they have competed in any other classes
 at a 4-H show.

MINIATURE HORSE DIVISION

• Pueblo County 4-H Miniature show will follow the current American Miniature Horse Association rules. MAXIMUM HEIGHT AT WITHERS 38". AMHA registration is not required.

RANCH HORSE DIVISION

- Exhibitors may only show one horse throughout the entire Working Ranch Horse Division.
- Showmanship -- Horses are to be shown in a good, plain working halter: braided, nylon or plain leather. ROPE HALTERS OR BRONC HALTERS ARE NOT PERMITTED. (per State Rulebook page 17)
- Ranch Horse Grooming (per State Rulebook page 94) 1. No hoof polish, or hoof black. 2. 2 No braided or banded manes/tails or tail extensions. 3. Trimming inside ears is discouraged. 4. Trimming bridle path, fetlocks and/or excessive (long) facial hair is allowed.
- Note: Equipment with silver should not count over a good working outfit. Excessive silver on bridles and saddles is discouraged.

AWARDS

- Ribbons in each class through 10th place <u>OR</u> Exhibitor may choose to collect Horsey Bucks instead of ribbons.
 \$1 for each ribbon they earned and use the money towards prizes at the HORSEY BUCKS STORE.
- Overall Grand and Reserve awards in each Age group/Level in all Divisions. Grand and Reserve winners will earn money towards purchases in the HORSEY BUCKS STORE.
- The 4-H Written test class will be included with all other classes in that division in high point tabulation. The written test in that division must be taken to be eligible to compete in any classes. Ties for overall awards will be broken by the most 1st placings received in the Division. A second tie will be broken by the most 2nd placings received in the Division, etc.
- MANDATORY FUNDRAISERS: To be eligible for County Fair or Year End Awards, members must participate in one Horse Council mandatory active fundraiser <u>AND</u> Buckle Sponsorship Requirement (to be determined by Horse Council) Minimum \$20 Award Sponsorship is due by Spring show May 3, 2024.
